

Headphones Pouch

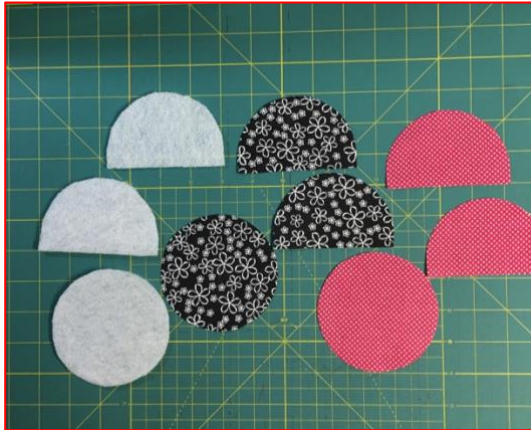


Finished size: ~ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " circle

You need:

- 1 piece - 6" x 10" outer fabric
- 1 piece - 6" x 10" lining fabric
- 1 piece - 6" x 10" thin iron on batting
- 1 piece - 2" x 3/8" wide grosgrain ribbon
- 1 - $\frac{3}{4}$ " split ring/ key ring
- 1 - $\frac{1}{2}$ " swivel hook (optional)
- Paper to draw template on
- Sewing machine and general sewing supplies

Draw two circles on a piece of paper that's about 4" - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in diameter. Use a large mug or something similar as a template. Cut out the two circles and cut one of them in half.



Use the full circle to cut out one piece each from the outer fabric, lining fabric and batting.

Use the half circle to cut out one piece each from the outer fabric, lining fabric and batting adding $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance to the straight edge.

Iron on the batting to the outer fabric pieces.



Place an outer half circle and lining half circle right sides together and stitch along the straight edge with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.



Iron the seam apart and fold wrong sides together. Press and top stitch along the straight edge.

Annika's Sewing Corner

Place the full circle pieces wrong pieces and quilt all three pieces as desired. Here are three different ideas.



Fold the ribbon in half and baste to the front of the full circle, raw edges even. Sew a few times over the ribbon for extra security.



Place the two half circles together so they are overlapping about $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Together they should be the same size as the full circle.



Place the two circles right sides together. Make sure the ribbon is where the half circles overlap. Sew around with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Cut the seam allowance with pinking shears or cut out small triangles with normal scissors to minimize bulk.



Don't cut off the extra stitches to reinforce the ribbon.



Turn to the right side and push the seam out all the way around. Place a pin in the middle through all layers to keep it closed while top stitching. Top stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge and a second time close to the edge if desired.



Attach a split ring/ key ring to the ribbon and a swivel hook if desired.
