

Gift Card Wallet



Materials:

- 1 piece - 4 ½" x 8 ½" - outer fabric
- 1 piece - 4 ½" x 8 ½" - lining fabric
- 2 pieces - 4" x 8" - iron on medium weight interfacing
- 1 plastic snap button
- General sewing supplies



Round the corners on one short edge of each 4" x 8" interfacing piece. Mark one corner as shown in the picture, fold lengthwise and cut on the marked line.

Mark ½" in from the middle point on the other short edge. Make a "half circle shape" like in the picture. At the edge it should be approximately 2" wide. Unless you have a round shape to trace, draw half the shape, fold and cut as for the rounded corners.



Iron on one interfacing piece on the outer fabric and one on the lining fabric. Place the interfacing so there is a ¼" seam allowance around the interfacing and cut the fabric away as necessary.

Mark placement for the snap, 1 ¼" from the short edge with rounded corners, centred, on both pieces. On the outer piece, mark 1" from the "deepest" part of the cut out half circle. Measure from the fabric edge and use a pen that will not disappear with heat.
